

Adaptive Swim Lessons

Adaptive swim lessons are designed for anyone with neurological, developmental and cognitive challenges, and teaches them independence swimming and water safety. By introducing students to the water gradually in a quiet setting in private lessons, they are better able to focus their attention. An individual assessment will be done by a certified instructor in order to determine the skill level of the participant. Each session includes eight (8), thirty (30) minute private lessons.

Instructors use specialized teaching tools for participants with a variety of special needs. This allows the student...

- To overcome fear of the water
- An opportunity to be independent in the water
- The freedom of being in water
- Success in all levels of swimming
- Relief from pain and muscle spasms
- To increase strength and balance
- To improve dexterity and fine motor skills

Swim School Policies and Procedures

- Before arriving to class, please sign in each day and **pay at the front desk on your first day of classes**. If you have a balance on your account it must be paid in full before continuing on with swim school. Each time you come to the Kingsport Aquatic Center for a swim class please **check in at the front desk**. The Team will keep track of your attendance.
- If you are going to miss a adaptive class, please give us **24 hours' notice**. Stop by or call the facility and **fill out a cancellation form**. Lack of notice may forfeit your class. Adaptive classes are **offered one (1) makeup class each session**. If an emergency arises and you are unable to give 24 hours' notice, please call the front desk at (423) 343-9758 and we will work on getting a makeup lesson scheduled.
- Please arrive at least 5 minutes before the start of your class and meet the instructor at the designated area. Do not enter the water until class begins. Instructors are only required to wait 15 minutes for your arrival before they leave. If they have waited 15 minutes and you are still not there, no makeup class will be provided.
- Please be available for your child at the end of class. Parents/guardians of all children must be available to escort them to the bathroom.
- Please remember that the **fee paid is for classes only**. This does not include free swim time for the student or his/her family before, during or after class. Please refer to the open swim times advertised in the information brochure. Regular admission fees or memberships may apply.
- We invite parents/guardians to observe classes from the pool deck, but please refrain from communicating with students or instructors during classes. If you need to speak with the instructor please do so before or after class.
- Children who are not potty trained must wear a swim diaper under their swimsuit. If you do not own a swim diaper, you may purchase one at our front desk.
